RUSTIC NOMADIC

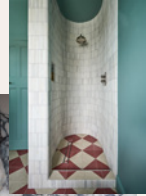
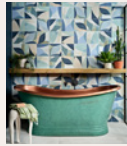

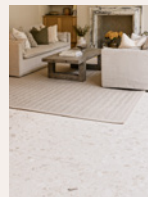




NATURE'S WAY
